SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

General information: In all cases of doubt, or when symptoms persist, seek medical advice.
If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.

In case of inhalation: If breathing is difficult, remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Seek medical attention if problems persist.

After eye contact: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
In case of eye irritation consult an ophthalmologist.

After swallowing: Immediately get medical attention.
Rinse mouth immediately and drink plenty of water.
Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do not induce vomiting.
Observe risk of aspiration if vomiting occurs.

May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways.

Treat symptomatically.



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SECTION 5: Firefighting measures

5.1 Extinguishing media
